

Notes on Walking in the Aegean Islands by Dieter Graf (2000 edition)

<p><b>Walk 40 (Serifos)</b></p>	<p>Quite a good walk, but not as good as Raymond Verdoolaege's similar (but not identical) one.</p>	
<p>page 170</p>	<p>Line 26 You need to turn right immediately at the end of the walled in section of path. From here for the next few minutes there is no path and you must go across country.</p> <p>Line 31 You need to go close to the building in photo 6 and turn right down the walled path. Where this path ends, go left and continue ignoring a walled path off to the right. Where the path forks, go right to a T junction where you turn right.</p>	
<p><b>Walk 44 (Sifnos)</b></p>	<p>A very nice walk, but be careful of the sketch map on page 189,; it is misleading.</p>	
<p>page 188</p>	<p>Line 21 The third time that the staircase crosses the road it is a tarmac road. At the top of the staircase, you turn right on to a dirt road, then right on to an asphalt road. Follow this road round to the left and turn right on to a walled-lined track, which is waymarked. This leads up and across the Artemonas-Cheronisos main road to Agia Anna.</p>
